# Big Tom's Barber Shop

### PROJECT NARRATIVE

Thomas Boyd, Sr. has rented the location for his barbershop, Big Tom's, at 2042 Centre Ave. for 14 years. He now has exclusive negotiating rights with the URA to purchase and relocate his barbershop to a larger space at 2178 Centre Ave. The new location is a 4,200 square foot, three-story, brick building located at the corner of Centre Ave. and Kirkpatrick St. In additional to the barbershop, the commercial space includes a 250 sf space which will provide a unique opportunity for a commercial tenant looking for a well-located space that is a unique size in high demand and low supply in the neighborhood. The adjacent lots will be used for outdoor deck/lounge space that could be utilized by the community at times and at other times by utilized by neighborhood home-based businesses for pop-up sales and demonstrations. This use is based on years of requests that Mr. Boyd has been unable to accommodate in his current location.

Mr. Boyd will also own and rent the upper-floors as affordable residential apartment units, which if adequate funding is obtained, will be reserved for families earning 80% to 50% AMI based upon funding. The building located at 2178 Centre Ave. is a historically important building to the Hill for several reasons. First, the building was previously owned and operated by the proprietor of Hamm's Barbershop, a long-time cornerstone of the Hill District until Mr. Hamm's passing nearly a decade ago. Since then, the building has sat vacant and deteriorated. The building in need of a total gut/rehab, but it also has incredible potential to be returned to a highly productive and valued use. Second, the building sits at the eastern gateway to the core of the Hill District's commercial corridor and revitalizing this building is a strong signal of the nascent turnaround of the Hill's commercial corridor. Finally, the revitalization of this site will build off of other important investments in close proximity, including the recently renovated library across the street.

This project falls within the planning area designated as the "Centre of Opportunity" – "the Centre of Opportunity is the heart of the entrepreneurial community in the Hill. Its strong character is built on the historic buildings that invite small businesses, shops, cafes, galleries, and others to own or rent space. TomTom24, being a homegrown project by a Hill District resident, achieves the stated desire that "Hill District Residents are Given Opportunity to Develop Businesses and Own Property in the District".
